LOOK AT THE ARTWORKS... LOOK- WITH YOUR EYES, YOUR MIND AND YOUR HEART. I RECOMMEND A VISITOR TO THE GALLERY FIRST TAKE A GLANCE AROUND THE EXHIBIT AT THE WORK. DON'T FORGET TO LOOK FOR THE ARTIST(S) NAME(S). HAS THE ARTIST PROVIDED TITLE CARDS? HE OR SHE WILL TYPICALLY DO SO AND THESE CARDS CAN BE HELPFUL IN UNDERSTANDING THE WORK - BOTH THE INTENDED PURPOSE AND HOW THE WORK HAS BEEN MADE. LOOK FOR AN ARTIST'S STATEMENT, IT MAY SHARE FURTHER INSIGHTS THAT MIGHT ENHANCE THE VIEWING EXPERIENCE AND GIVE YOU A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE ARTIST'S GOALS AND BACKGROUND.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE, <u>PLEASE SIGN THE GUEST BOOK</u>.

AGAIN, DON'T FORGET THAT LOOKING AT THE

ARTWORK, WITH AN INQUIRING AND OPEN MIND,




