Meet general university graduate admissions requirements
Two letters of recommendation addressing a candidate's professional and academic potential
Submission of GMAT or GRE scores is recommended but not required
Successful completion of Math 1003 –College Algebra or a higher-level math course
A minimum GPA of 3.000 on a 4.000 scale - <i>conditional admission is considered for applicants who meet all other admission requirements and have a GPA below 3.000, but not lower than 2.500.</i>
Two or more years of full-time work experience
